Extract from the will of the late Thomas
Foster of Carr House dated 29 January 1835 -

" I give the Sum of Two hundred pounds unto the
Trustees for the time being of the particular Baptist
Chapel at Hebdon Budge to be paid at the
same time as the last mentioned Legacies out
of my personal Estate Exclusively and to which
Sum I direct them to invest at Interest
on good and sufficient security And as to
one Hundred pounds part thereof to apply
the interest thereof for the general purposes
of the Sunday School attached to the said
Chapel and as to the remaining One Hundred
pounds to pay the interest thereof to the Minister
for the time being of the said Chapel so long as
he give satisfaction to the Members of the Church
and the Congregation with power for a Majority
of the Church Members in case of there being
no Sunday School attached to the said
Chapel or of their disapproval of the Minister
for the time being as the case may be to apply
the same Interest respectively in such other
way or manner for the general purposes
of the Chapel as they may in their discretion
think fit" -
