We are acting for Martins Bank Ltd., the Executor of the Will of the above named, who died on 18th April last, and are instructed to inform the Deacons of Hope Baptist Chapel, Hebden Bridge, that by his Will the deceased gave to them, free of duty, £150 GREAT WESTERN RAILWAY 5% Consolidated Pref. Stock upon trust to pay or apply 1/3rd of the income thereof to-wards the Sunday School Fund and 2/3rds of the income thereof to the Church fund.
